

FINANCIAL DETAILS OF THE WILL

(probated 7/23/1890)

CONTAINED IN SECTIONS FIRST THROUGH THE SIXTH WERE THE FOLLOWING:

1. to certain individuals \$ 19,000.00
2. to the Freedman's Aid Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church for the sole use and benefit of the Gilbert Seminary, Winsted, La Teche, La. 40,000.00
3. to the Protestant Episcopal Church, Northfield, Litchfield, Connecticut 3,000.00
4. to the Congregational Society, Northfield, Litchfield, Connecticut 12,000.00
5. All that tract of land lying northerly and westerly of Williams Avenue which was deeded to me by Henry Gay together with all the buildings located thereon
6. to the William L. Gilbert Home, along with the land noted above 400,000.00

7. the residue of the estate to The Gilbert School (a)
Isaac B. Woodruff and Henry Gay were appointed executors of the will of William Lewis Gilbert, which was signed on March 22, 1880 and placed in the custody of the Hulbut Bank.

Footnote (a) a codicil to the will, which reduced the "residue" of the estate by \$48,000.00, was signed and witnessed on June 11, 1890, in Cedar Dale, Ontario, Canada, for the purpose of improving Winsted's water supply if specified dams and canals were constructed.
